

For Action:

Referral of Approved National Certifying Bodies to the 225th General Assembly (2022)

Recommendation: That the Committee on the Office of the General Assembly, at the recommendation of the Stated Clerk, recommend that the 226th General Assembly (2024) delay the agency entire review process by two additional years. The schedule would be impacted in this way:

- **GA226 authorizing formation of review committees for BOP, the Foundation, and ILP to report to GA227 in 2026**
- **GA227 authorizing formation of review committees for OGA, PMA, and PPC to report to GA228 in 2028**
- **GA228 authorizing the formation of an all-agency review committee which would include a review of A Corp to report to GA229 in 2030**

Background: The 225th General Assembly authorized the creation of review committees to review the Board of Pensions, the Presbyterian Foundation, and the Investment and Loan Program. While the General Assembly Nominating Committee actively sought and encouraged applications, not enough individuals applied to serve on the three committees. We even thought creatively to reduce the required number of members to appoint one committee of 15 members who would have three subcommittees to conduct the three reviews. However, there were still not enough applicants. Recognizing the important and important task undertaken by these committees, the Stated Clerk has recommended that we delay the process by two years.
