Prayer of Intercession

This prayer may be used as a litary by adding those portions in bold face type with appropriate instructions to the congregation.

Almighty God, You have gathered us in this community of faith in order that we might shine with Your love in this dark and dreary world.

Take hold of our souls in these moments, by the power of the Holy Spirit, that our prayers may be commitments to act in accord with Your gracious will, through Jesus Christ our Lord,

Amen. or hear our prayer.

God of mercy, You have claimed all of us to be the church of Jesus Christ in this world. Fuse us into one people by the fire of Your Holy Spirit,

that we may be strong to carry one another's burdens.

We pray for those who suffer in the silence of grief....

for those afflicted with illness in body or mind....

for the poor and the hungry and the homeless....

and we remember before You in the silence of our hearts

all with special needs known to us and to You....

Give us strength to endure, O God, and relieve and heal every pain and sorrow.
...through Jesus Christ our Lord, hear our prayer.

God of might, You have sent all of us into this world

as agents of Christ's love.

Inspire us by the Holy Spirit to brave and bold discipleship

in ministries near and far.

Especially we remember today (Name[s])

Whom You have claimed for special service in (Place[s]).

As they go forth in Christ's name,

(or As they return from this distant field,)

We pray Your constant renewal and refreshment in their lives,

that they may continue in strength to serve the cause of Christ.

Specific intercessions for the missionaries may be offered at this point, concluding, if appropriate, with the litary response.

O God, Ruler of the Universe, we pray for all the nations and peoples of the earth.

We rejoice in the richness of your creation, the wealth of diversity in culture and custom, the beauty of the different races, the melodies of languages and tongues, the challenge of religions and beliefs.

We pray for all who are different from ourselves for we know we are the same in our human need,

and in the deep desires of our hearts.

Give to all the gift of faith, the joy of Your loving embrace,
and the blessings of salvation.

...through Jesus Christ our Lord, hear our prayer.

Specific intercessions for the regions or nations may be offered at this point, concluding, if appropriate, with the litary response.

Great God, You have shaped all people in Your image,

and You gave Jesus Christ to make us all sisters and brothers

in one family of faith.

May we be ambassadors of peace

to those far away and those who are near.

By the power of Your Holy Spirit guide all nations of the world

in the way of the Savior, and bring about Your eternal purpose for all peoples,

through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen. *or* hear our prayer.

Charge to the People

Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good;
