**Order Dismissing Appeal**

This matter comes before the Permanent Judicial Commission of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) pursuant to its own motion after an interim order had been issued by the Moderator and the Clerk of the Commission.

The record discloses that this appeal was filed on or about July 24, 1984. After the time for filing the Appellant's brief had expired, Complainant-Appellant requested an extension of time to file, which was granted, and again, after that extended time period had expired, Complainant-Appellant was granted an additional extension of time until December 1, 1984. As of January 4, 1985, no brief had been filed.

The Commission considers the Complainant-Appellant's delinquencies and his failure to file his brief in a timely fashion as a waiver of his right to file a brief and an abandonment of his appeal. (D-13.0800).

This order, issued on February 17, 1985, by the entire Permanent Judicial Commission of the General Assembly, confirms the interim order issued January 4, 1985. The Appeal is hereby dismissed.
