THE PRESBYTERY OF "E"

This case has come before the Commission on appeal by Thomas B. Hoover from a decision by the permanent judicial commission of the Synod of Mid-Atlantic dismissing Mr. Hoover's complaint against Presbytery "E."

The complaint was dismissed on the grounds that Presbytery"E" was not at the time of the complaint a duly constituted entity of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and, therefore, is not subject to the judicial processes of the church.

The executive committee concurs.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the decision of the permanent judicial commission of the Synod of Mid-Atlantic be upheld and the case dismissed.

This order, issued by the executive committee in its meeting of December 13, 1988, is subject to ratification by the full Commission at its meeting February 1989 in Atlanta, Georgia.

This order was ratified by the Permanent Judicial Commission at its meeting in Atlanta, Georgia in February, 1989.
