These consolidated remedial cases have come before this Commission on appeals by the named Appellants from decisions of the Permanent Judicial Commission of the Synod of Lincoln Trails dismissing the complaints..

Pursuant to D-13.1200a, this Commission finds that it has jurisdiction and that Appellants have standing to appeal the dismissals.

With regard to the remedial case entitled Lorine Lundin, Complainant/Appellant vs. Presbytery of Chicago, Respondent/Appellee, this Commission finds that at the time of the irregularities complained of, Appellant was not an enrolled member of the Presbytery of Chicago. Therefore, Appellant had no standing to file the Complaint, and the decision of the Synod Permanent Judicial Commission dismissing the Complaint is affirmed. D-6.0500b.

With regard to the remaining remedial cases, the Appellants asked to withdraw the appeals. This Commission finds that the ends of justice would not be defeated by the withdrawal of these appeals. D-13.0200. Therefore, these appeals are dismissed.
