REMEDIAL CASE 209-8

This remedial case has come before this Commission on a preliminary order issued by the Moderator and Clerk of the Commission recommending dismissal of the appeal. The full Commission has considered the materials submitted by the parties and the record of the case and finds that despite its styling as a remedial case, the record shows that it is an attempted appeal of a disciplinary case. This cannot be done under our Rules of Discipline (Evans v. Presbytery of Lake Michigan, *Minutes*, 11995, 121). In addition, the only party who can appeal a disciplinary case is the accused. D-13.0100b*

Accordingly, this Commission ORDERS that the appeal be dismissed.
