This remedial case came before this Commission on a complaint filed by the Presbytery of Baltimore, a constituent presbytery of the Synod of the Mid-Atlantic, against the Synod of the Mid-Atlantic dated June 24, 2004.

The Executive Committee of the General Assembly Permanent Judicial Commission found that the General Assembly Permanent Commission has jurisdiction, that the complainant has standing to file the complaint, that the complaint was timely filed, and that the complaint states a claim upon which relief can be granted.

The Synod of the Mid-Atlantic purportedly took an action at a stated meeting on July 14 - 16, 2004, rescinding the action which was the subject matter of the Complaint. The Presbytery of Baltimore has requested that its Complaint against the Synod of the Mid-Atlantic be dismissed as being moot.

The Complaint of the Presbytery of Baltimore will be dismissed upon receipt of a copy of the official minutes of the Synod of the Mid-Atlantic showing that the complained of action has been rescinded. Until such receipt, this matter remains pending before this Commission.
