Torn Bandage Order Form

You may remember tearing sheets apart into 3- to 4-inch strips and rolling them tightly to form simple bandages. At one time, these strips were an important part of Presbyterian Women's Mission Opportunities program (later, Together in Service) and were sent to medical clinics in developing countries. With the rise in international postage and the increased availability of medical supplies, the bandages have outlived their usefulness. They sit in boxes in the Brethren Service Center in New Windsor, Maryland, awaiting a new purpose.

Presbyterian Women and the Brethren Service Center have agreed to make the strips available to crafters, quilters and rug makers. They come in all colors and a variety of widths. Since the staff at the Brethren Center is mostly volunteer and very busy, they are unable to sort the rolls, but will stuff them in boxes and mail them to people who would put them to good use. Note that only full boxes may be ordered. There are about 50 in a medium-sized box, and 70 in a large box. Send your fees to the Brethren Service Center with your completed order form.

I understand and agree to the following: There is no quality control. Bandages will not be examined for quality of fabric before shipping. The recipient agrees to accept what is shipped. Strips may be any color and/or width; most will be three to six inches wide. Fees, cash or check, must accompany the order. Fees are payable to Brethren Service Center. Presbyterian Women is not involved in financial aspects of this project. All orders will be for complete boxes. No small lots are permitted. Orders for multiple boxes will receive no discount. Should flat rate postage increase, the charge per box will increase by the amount of the postage increase.

Torn bandages will be shipped in USPS flat rate medium and/or large boxes so that computation of postage and weights does not burden the Center staff. Fees include standard flat rate shipping fees plus a handling and processing fee for each box.
